Nothing can surpass the adventure of the Historic Apache Trail in beauty and variety. There are many wonderful shops to browse and enjoy. You can "Do the Trail" in a day, or just do a part of it. The Mountain's beauty and mystery will be with you wherever you go. The Boyce Thompson Arboretum is just up the road (Hwy. 60) toward Superior. The area is constantly growing, and you'll be sure to find a place you haven't visited before.

Be sure to visit the Superstition Mountains Historical Museum and learn about the area's history as you browse the displays and read of the wonderful history surrounding the Superstition Mountains. Hike the nearby trails and see old working mining equipment and take a tour of the remaining buildings from the former movie set of Apacheland, which burned to the ground except for the 'Rifleman's barn' and the Elvis Presley Memorial Chapel. These were donated to the museum, and were disassembled and moved to the museum grounds and rebuilt.

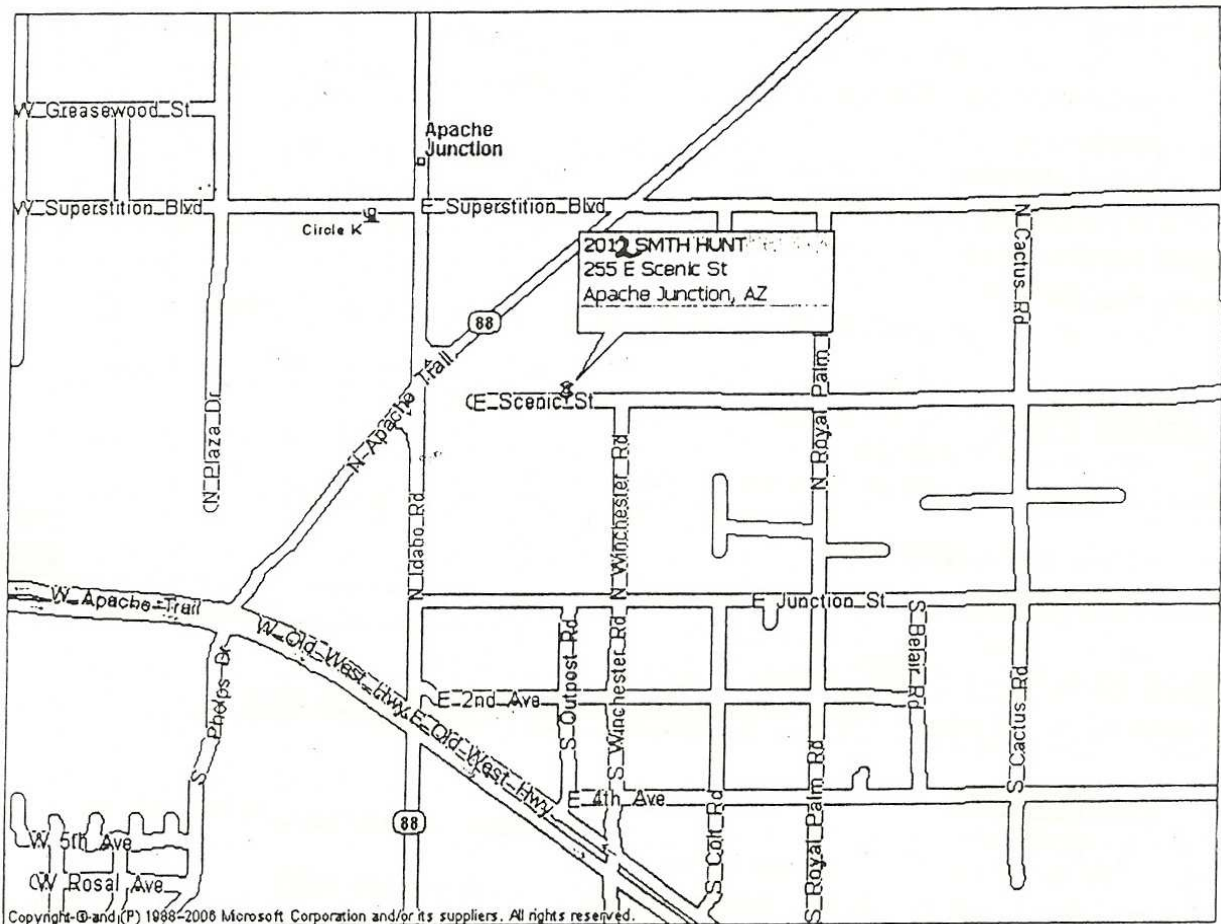
